Increase the percentage of:

Students in 2019 Year 3 Reading at or above the NAPLAN NMS from 75% to 80% in 2021 Year 5 Reading.

Students in 2019 Year 5 Reading at or above the NAPLAN NMS from 58% to 75% in 2021 Year 7 Reading.

Students in 2019 Year 7 Reading at or above the NAPLAN NMS from 42.9% to 55% in 2021 Year 9 Reading.

Year 12 students attaining Queensland Certificate of Education (QCE) maintained at 100%. Employ an additional Head of Department to support the primary staff in unpacking units of work and engaging in collegial coaching cycles to quality ensure practice and improve student outcomes.

Our initiatives include

Implementation of the Write2Spell2Read literacy program across Kindy to year 7 to lay solid foundation in phonological awareness and support improvements in reading levels across the early years to regional benchmarks.

Engage consultant (Bwgcolman Brain Business) to continue to embed Bwgcolman Professional Learning and Practice Communities (BPLPCs) to build staff capability through understanding the neuroscience of the teaching of reading in the curriculum in line with state education expectations.

Continue to embed regional priorities across the school, ie Before/After/After/End model for whole school moderation.

Provide instructional coaching and leadership, professional development and training opportunities to enhance staff capability and further develop BCS capability for mentoring beginning teachers.

Expand the Bwgcolman Strong program to encourage enrolement of disengaged/non –attending students to reengage with schooling.

Employ additional teacher aides to support reading in the curriculum

Employ additional teachers to reduce impact on student learning from staff absences.
